## Jumpers Pairs

This game is where two dogs complete the course, one after the other. The second dog must not start until the first dog has completed its last obstacle. Where the second dog starts before the first dog finishes the team will be disqualified.

## Teams.

The Club is allowed to specify single height or mixed height teams. Where two heights are permitted the courses will obviously need to be different, although tunnels can be shared. Each dog must negotiate a certain number of obstacles. In Grade C this is $8-10$ obstacles, and in Grade B it is 10-12. The Jumpers ROT is used to determine SCT for Jumpers pairs.

Qualification certificates will go to both members of the pair if they get a clear round under the SCT. If one dog gets faults and the other goes clear the whole Team gains faults, and neither dog gets a qualification certificate.
